The Trent Valley Archives has recently received the Electric City Photo Collection. Over 600 photos were gathered by Bruce Dyer and Elwood Jones for their 1987 book *Peterborough: The Electric City* published by California based Windsor Publications. The photos were researched for possible inclusion in the book, and about 20 percent were actually used. The photos were selected for their quality, for their accessibility and for the pertinence to the themes of the book.

Some photos provide overviews of the town and city. Others highlight key places within the town. Some of the events have been captured. While there are some portraits, people appear in the context of events. The photos are divided into three series - before 1875, 1876 to 1925, and after 1925. The pictures are available for research purposes, but publication limitations may apply. Each photo has a control sheet containing pertinent information, including a potential cutline.
